The First Commandment

Genesis 1:28 "Be fruitful & multiply; fill the earth and subdue it."

The 1st Century

The 21st Century

1. As members of God's family, we are to go, sow & grow.

vv.19-26

Go where He leads.

Sow the Gospel seeds.

Grow ourselves & others in Christ.

- 2. When we are <u>surrendered</u> to the Lord, He uses us to bring others to salvation. v.21
- 3. We should be truly <u>interested</u> in what God is doing in the lives of others. vv.22-23

We should listen for good <u>testimonies</u>.

We should look for reasons to rejoice.

4. We should seek to encourage others in their <u>walk</u> with Christ, vv.23-26

even if it means personal risk. (with Saul)

even if it means <u>personal</u> scrutiny. (true, faithful, whole heart)

even if it means personal cost. (travel to Tarsus)

even if it means extended <u>commitment</u>. (a whole year)

even if it means shared reward. (partnered with Saul)

5. We are to raise up "Little Christs" along the way. v.26

The 1st Century

- 1. When the earliest Believers were persecuted, they became evangelists & missionaries. vv.19-20
 - -to fellow Jews
 - -to Gentiles
- 2. The Lord blessed them, leading to a "great number" of people repenting (turning) from their sin & trusting in Christ. v.21
- 3. The Mother Church (Jerusalem) heard what was happening in Antioch & sent Barnabas. v.22
- 4. The Mother Church (Jerusalem) sought to encourage their spiritual children in Antioch by sending Barnabas. vv.22-24 Barnabas
 - -a good man v.24
 - -full of the Holy Spirit v.24
 - -full of faith v.24
 - -named Joseph, but nicknamed "Son of Encouragement" by the Apostles – Acts 4:36
 - -he was an encouraging force, an edifying personality, even willing to risk his own reputation in order to stand alongside those he sought to defend (Saul) Acts 9:27
- 5. Barnabas was glad to see that the people in Antioch had turned to Christ. v.23
 - -they exhibited evidence of God's grace
 - -he encouraged them to stay true, faithful to Christ with their whole hearts
- 6. Barnabas' encouragement fanned the flame of evangelism. v.24
 -"a great number of people were brought to the Lord"
- 7. Barnabas anticipated the mutual benefit of bringing Saul & the Antioch Believers together. vv.25-26
 - -he went to Tarsus & found Saul
 - -he brought Saul to Antioch
 - -they met with the church in Antioch for a whole year & taught "great numbers of people"
- 8. The followers of Christ were first called Christians at Antioch.
