Selected Scriptures

The Lord's Supper

is **NOT** the means by which God makes us part
of His family. Matthew 12:46-50

is the Biblical means by which God's family
remembers, honors & gives thanks for
Christ bringing us into His family.

1 Corinthians:23-24

is the Biblical method for God's family to
proclaim Christ's sacrificial death for the
sins of humanity. 1 Corinthians 11:25-26

is the Biblically prescribed corporate reminder
that Christ is coming back to retrieve
those who are in God's family.

John 14:1-6

Believer's Baptism

is **NOT** the act by which God confers eternal
salvation on a person.

1 Corinthians 10:1-2

is the act by which a person confesses that they
have received eternal salvation from God
(by His grace through that person's
faith). Acts 8:12; 10:47-48; 16:29-33; 18:8

is the prescribed public & personal
identification with Jesus' death, burial &
resurrection. Galatians 3:26-27

is the initial, publicly-personal expression of a
Believer's death to self, & new life in
Christ. Colossians 2:12; Romans 6:3-4
