"prayer"

"meet together in the temple courts"

"praising God"

4. Ministry vv.44 &45, 4:32

"had everything in common"

"selling their possessions and goods,

they gave to anyone as he had need"

"they shared everything they had"

5. Evangelism v.47, 4:33

"enjoying the favor of all the people"

"testify to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus"
