Lessons for Us

1. Remember that sometimes those who are most united in Christ have differences of opinion. We are fallible, although God is not. (Just because you have the right to your opinion, doesn't mean that your opinion is right.)
-Humility, putting others before yourself.
2. Christians can disagree, but should never get disagreeable. (Disagree, but don't get disagreeable.)
-Brotherly love.
3. Our differences with other Christians should always be reconcilable. If Jesus can reconcile us with the Heavenly Father, then He can reconcile us with each other. (Seek reconciliation through Christ.)
-Put away all bitterness, malice & envy.
4. When our lives are focused on Christ & His Kingdom, even that which devil intends for evil, God can use for good. (Focus on Christ & His Kingdom.)
