Concerning Our Enemy: vv.16-18

- 1. Demons are real. v.16
- 2. Demons have <u>power</u> in the natural world & in the supernatural world. vv.16-18
 - -Demons can possess people. v.16
 - -Demons can exercise their power <u>through</u> people. vv.16-18
 - -Demons can make their work look like <u>blessings</u> they are master deceivers. vv.16-18
- 3. Demons are to be <u>dealt</u> with in the name of Jesus, not <u>dabbled</u> with in the name of fun. vv.18
 - -The missionaries didn't allow the demon to continue <u>testifying</u> about them or Christ.
