## God's Kingdom: Family Where People Are Nurtured & Encouraged — Part 2

## **There**

- 1. The Lord used Barnabas & Saul to create an environment of Christian spiritual growth (a spiritual nursery for the Antioch Gentiles who had recently been born again). vv.25-26
- 2. The Lord chose a nurturing church environment to bless with <u>His Word</u> (prophets). v.27 "During this time"
- 3. The Lord used Christian prophets from Jerusalem to encourage & challenge the Antioch Christians to grow up in Christ (think & act maturely). vv.27-28
- 4. The Antioch Christians showed growing maturity by taking care of their <u>spiritual parents</u> (the Believers in Jerusalem). vv.29-30
  - 1. They helped <u>willingly</u>, not under compulsion from outsiders. "The disciples...decided" v.29
  - 2. They helped <u>thankfully</u>, lovingly & thoughtfully, for those whom God had used to bring hope to them. "the brothers living in Judea" v.29
  - 3. They helped <u>personally</u>, not in competition with others. "each according to his ability" v.29
  - 4. They helped <u>corporately</u>, as a family. "their gift" v.30
  - 5. They helped generously, not expecting to be repaid. "their *gift*" v.30
  - 6. They helped <u>carefully</u> by sending their gift *to* those whom they could trust (the elders of the Jerusalem church) *by way of* those whom they could trust (Barnabas & Saul). v.30

## **Here**

- 1. Work hard to create an environment of Christian <u>spiritual</u> growth wherever you are for yourself, & for others.
- 2. Seek to be encouraged & challenged by God's Word every day.
- 3. Nurture Christian maturity by <u>serving & giving</u> like the Christians in Antioch; like Christ at Calvary.
