Review of the Initiation

God initiated the plan for His Kingdom to include all who believe.

vv.1-23

He sent an angel to Cornelius.

He persuaded Peter through a vision.

Preview of the Invitations

Peter invites the Gentile ambassadors to lodge with him.

Cornelius invites Peter to share the Gospel.

Cornelius invites his family & friends to hear the Gospel.

Peter accepts the invitation & shares Christ.

God invites Cornelius & the others to trust Christ.

Peter invites the new Believers to testify through baptism.

Closer View of God's Invitation

God's Invitation is –

- 1. For <u>all</u> people through <u>His</u> people. vv.34-36 (33,42) Ephesians 2:11-13
- 2. Receive <u>forgiveness</u> of sins through <u>faith</u> in Jesus Christ. v.43 Acts 4:12
- 3. <u>Peace</u> with God through Jesus Christ. v.36 Ephesians 2:14-18
- 4. Receive the <u>Holy Spirit</u> as God's seal of grace, & call to service. vv.44-47 Ephesians 1:13-14, Ephesians 2:8-10
- 5. Identify with Jesus' death, burial & resurrection through Believer's <u>baptism</u>. vv.47-48
 Colossians 2:9-15, Romans 6:3-4

So what?

If you are not a Christian, receive His invitation: <u>trust</u> in Jesus Christ & <u>join</u> His Kingdom.

If you are a Christian, deliver His invitation: <u>share</u> Jesus Christ & <u>grow</u> His Kingdom.
