### Review

God initiated the opening of His Kingdom to the Gentiles. God invited the first Gentile family to join His Kingdom by trusting Christ.

### Preview

God brought unity between Jews & Gentiles in His Kingdom.

## The Explanation: From the Big Picture to the Portrait

1. This passage marks the <u>third</u> consecutive time that Luke recorded this story. 10:1-23, 23-48, 11:1-18

Three times for clarity.

Three times for sincerity.

- 2. There were <u>seven</u> circumcised Christian witnesses who solemnly testified. vv.12-13
- 3. The Judean Christians were <u>prejudiced</u> against the Gentile Christians & <u>condemning</u> of Peter. vv.1-3
- 4. Peter responded <u>humbly</u> & <u>carefully</u>. v.4(5-17)
  - -He included his Jewish prejudice. vv.8-10
  - -He included details:

where he was. vv.5, 12

what he saw. vv.5-6

what he heard. vv.7-9, 12-13

what he said. vv.8, 15

what God did. vv.5-17

- 5. The Judean Christians' hearts were changed by God. v.18
  - -They stopped their prejudiced objecting.
  - -They <u>praised</u> God.
  - -They recognized that repentance is a <u>gift</u> from God for anyone who will trust Christ.
  - -They declared that true repentance results in <u>life</u>.

### Reminders for Us

- 1. Be mindful of your prejudices, & be prayerful about your judgments.
- 2. When you find yourself wrongfully accused or condemned:

Keep your cool

Stay humble

Be careful

3. Regardless which side you find yourself, love God:

Focus on Him

Hold on to Jesus

Keep your eyes on the Lord
