Acts 9:1-31

This is a story that every serious Christian needs to be familiar with - for a couple of reasons:

-Saul (Paul) was such a key, pivotal, significant person used by God in the establishment & expansion of His Kingdom.

- -Saul's historical, missional, logistical role of establishing & encouraging local churches through his three missionary journeys.
- -God's use of Paul in writing such a significant portion of Holy Scripture.
- -Saul's (Paul) testimony continues to stand as one of, if not the greatest, testimony of the overwhelming richness of God's grace that God can forgive anyone of any sin, that no one can be too bad for God to forgive them, & that God can call & powerfully use even the worst of all sinners.
- 1. God can use me no matter how <u>bad</u> I've been, or what evil I've done. (<u>Saul</u>)
- 2. God can use me when my reluctance gives way to <u>obedience</u>. (Ananias)
- 3. God can use me when I <u>tell others</u> what I've experienced. (<u>Barnabas</u>)
- 4. God can use me when I <u>surrender</u> to Jesus. (All)
